StFX's Gerald Schwartz School of Business Receives National CIM Accreditation

StFX's Gerald Schwartz School of Business has once again received external endorsement for the quality of its education. After a comprehensive review, the Canadian Institute of Management (CIM) has given the business program its national accreditation designation.

StFX is the first school in Nova Scotia, and only the second school in Atlantic Canada to hold this distinction.

"This accreditation speaks to the position of the Gerald Schwartz School of Business as a leader in the field of business and management education," says Dr. Matthew Jelavic, CIM's National President.

StFX Dean of Business Tim Hynes, PhD says it is great to receive the third-party, external validation of the program and to hear that it meets the standards of the professional organization; "It puts us a step above."

As well, he says from the prospective of StFX students, it provides easier access to post-graduation certification. "It puts them on a fast track to a professional designation."

Students graduating from StFX's Bachelor of Business Administration program, who have taken the required courses, will have met the academic requirements for the Certified in Management (C.I.M.) and Professional Manager (P.Mgr.) designations. In order to obtain these designations, graduates will need to demonstrate the appropriate level of managerial experience in the workplace or academia and submit the appropriate application and reference letters.

The accreditation started Sept. 1, 2011 and is valid for five years until Aug. 31, 2016, when a reassessment process will take place. As of September 1, 2016 StFX has been re-accredited by CIM National for an additional five years to 2021.

Certificate in Management and Administration

- Students will be awarded a **Certificate in Management and Administration** upon successful completion of the Bachelor of Business Administration program. This is a great showpiece for both your portfolio and job search.
- The prestigious **Certified in Management (C.I.M.)** Designation requires two years of documented supervisory/management experience in addition to completion of the Bachelor of Business Administration program.
- For students without managerial work experience, the two-year management experience requirement is usually completed after graduation. If you have had documented managerial work experience for two years, you may be able to apply for completion of this requirement. This experience must be documented by letters of reference, job descriptions and other work documents that unequivocally prove its authenticity.

How to Become a Maritime Chapter Member:

A Campus Member is a student enrolled in an StFX Bachelor of Business Administration Program. Becoming a **Campus Member** of the Canadian Institute of Management is easy. To become a member follow these steps:

- ✓ If you have completed courses within the last ten years that may be equivalent to any of the current required courses for the certificate in management program please provide an official transcript.
